The University is reviewing this matter, however the student has elected to not enroll at Millersville University this fall. The abhorrent post is not consistent with our EPPIC values of inclusion, integrity and compassion.

This past weekend, I put out a [joint statement](#) with my Chief Diversity Office and Vice President for Students Affairs and Enrollment Management asking our campus community to think and reflect deeply about our EPPIC Values. Millersville University remains committed to fostering an environment of inclusivity. We can and will create the kinds of communities we envision, where everyone can flourish and messages of intolerance are not welcome.

We have come far but we recognize that we have a long road to travel. We will travel that road together!
